## August 13, 2023 Twelfth Sunday of Pentecost

### Ephesians 3:1-13

Because of this, I, Paul, a prisoner of Christ (Jesus) for you Gentiles-- if, as I suppose, you have heard of the stewardship of God's grace that was given to me for your benefit, (namely, that) the mystery was made known to me by revelation, as I have

written briefly earlier. When you read this you can understand my insight into the mystery of Christ, which was not made known to human beings in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit, that the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel. Of this I became a minister by the gift of God's grace that was granted me in accord with the exercise of his power. To me, the very least of all the holy ones, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the inscrutable riches of Christ, and to bring to light (for all) what is the plan of



the mystery hidden from ages past in God who created all things, so that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the principalities and authorities in the heavens. This was according to the eternal purpose that he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness of speech and confidence of access through faith in him. So I ask you not to lose heart over my afflictions for you; this is your glory.

### Matthew 15:21-28

Then Jesus went from that place and withdrew to the region of Tyre and Sidon. And behold, a Canaanite woman of that district came and called out, "Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David! My daughter is tormented by a demon." But he did not say a word in answer to her. His disciples came and asked him, "Send her away, for she keeps calling out after us." He said in reply, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." But the woman came and did him homage, saying, "Lord, help me." He said in reply, "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs." She said, "Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters." Then Jesus said to her in reply, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish." And her daughter was healed from that hour.

Hail, holy Queen, Mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve: to thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious Advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary!

Leader: Pray for us O Holy Mother of God, All: That we may be worthy of the promises of Christ. **The Feast of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary** is celebrated on August 15th. It commemorates our Catholic belief that the Blessed Mother, the Virgin Mary was assumed into heaven both in body and soul after her earthly life had ended. Here are *three lessons* we reflect on from this feast:

1. Faith and Surrender to God's Will: The Assumption of Mary highlights the importance of faith and surrendering to God's will. Mary's life is an embodiment of trust and obedience to God's plan. Her acceptance of the angel's message at the Annunciation and her unwavering devotion to her son Jesus demonstrate her complete submission to God's divine plan. This feast reminds us to trust in God's guidance and have faith in His promises, even when we may not fully understand the path laid out before us.

2. **The Dignity of Human Life:** The Assumption of Mary emphasizes the dignity of human life and the potential for all humanity to participate in God's heavenly kingdom. It shows that God values each individual and has a plan for each one of us. Mary's assumption into heaven, body and soul, reflects the belief in the resurrection of the body and eternal life. This



feast reminds us of the sanctity of human life and the ultimate destiny of all believers to be united with God in heaven.

3. **The Role of Mary as Intercessor:** The Assumption of Mary also highlights her role as a powerful intercessor and advocate for humanity. Our Catholic Tradition sees Mary as the "Queen of Heaven," and we believe her to be our compassionate and caring mother who intercedes on behalf of believers. The feast encourages us to seek Mary's intercession in our lives and to turn to her as a source of comfort, support, and prayer.
