Ephesians 2:17-22

He came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near, for through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. So then you are no longer strangers and sojourners, but you are fellow citizens with the holy ones and members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the capstone. Through him the whole structure is held together and grows into a temple sacred in the Lord; in him you also are being built together into a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

And He was transfigured before them: 3 and His garments became radiant and exceedingly white, as no launderer on earth can whiten them. 4 And Elijah appeared to them along with Moses; and they were talking with Jesus. 5 Peter responded and *said to Jesus, "Rabbi, it is good that we are here; let's make three tabernacles, one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." 6 For he did not know how to reply; for they became terrified. 7 Then a cloud formed, overshadowing them, and a voice came out of the cloud: "This is My beloved Son; listen to Him!" 8 And suddenly they looked around and saw no one with them anymore, except Jesus alone. 9 As they were coming down from the mountain, He gave them orders not to relate to anyone what they had seen, until the Son of Man rose from the dead.

Lessons from the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord.

1. Revelation of Jesus' Divine Nature: The Transfiguration is a pivotal event in the life of Jesus as it reveals His divine nature and identity as the Son of God. The dazzling transformation of Jesus' appearance, accompanied by the appearance of Moses and Elijah, emphasizes Jesus' unique and divine status as the fulfillment of the Law and the Prophets.

- 2. Confirmation of Jesus' Mission: The event reinforces the importance and validity of Jesus' mission on Earth. It serves as a confirmation to the disciples and others that Jesus is the promised Messiah, and they are called to listen to and follow Him.
- 3. Foreshadowing of Christ's Glory: The Transfiguration foreshadows the glory of Jesus' resurrection and His future glorified state. It offers a glimpse of the resurrection body, giving hope to believers in Christ's victory over sin and death.
- 4. Connection with the Old Testament: The presence of Moses and Elijah during the Transfiguration connects Jesus with the history of Israel and the covenant God made with His people in the Old Testament. It symbolizes the continuity between the Law and the Prophets and Jesus' teachings in the New Testament.
- 5. The Trinity: During the Transfiguration, a voice from a bright cloud proclaims, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." This voice represents God the Father, affirming Jesus' identity as His Son. The presence of Jesus (the Son), the voice of God the Father, and the appearance of the Holy Spirit in the cloud also point to the revelation of Him faithfully.
